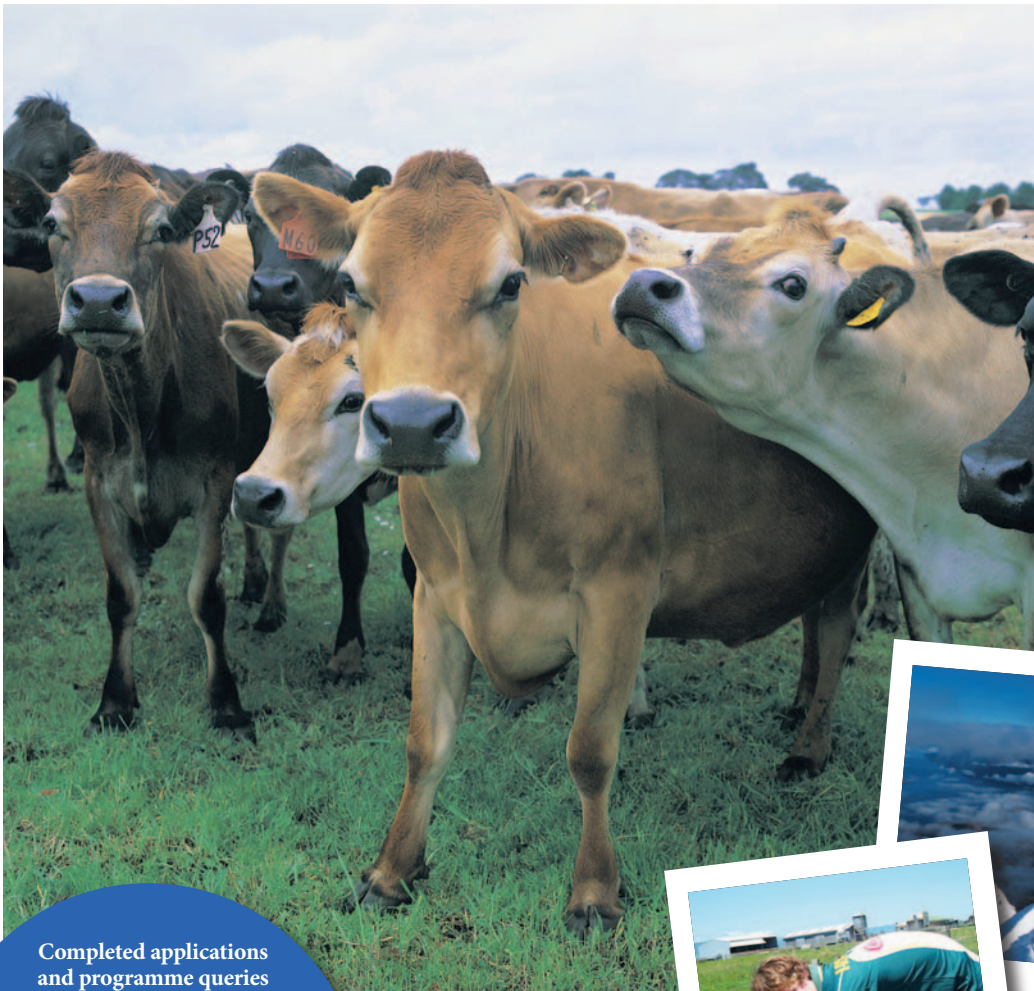

WHEN TO APPLY:

There are no application deadlines and positions are available all year round.

The best time to arrive is in or before July-August to catch calving period. This job is one of the longest available, and we believe there is an advantage in starting by assisting a farmer over the calving period (usually around six to ten weeks). It gives you the chance to settle into the New Zealand way of farming, and enables you to move on to jobs with more responsibility, and the potential to work up to farm management positions.
